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Withdrawals/Refunds

During the first four weeks of the term, when a student withdraws, tuition refunds follow the standard refund policy ([see Academic Calendar](#)).

- The first week of classes, tuition refunds will be processed at 100%
- The second week of classes, tuition refunds will be processed at 80%
- The third week of classes, tuition refunds will be processed at 40%
- The fourth week of classes, tuition refunds will be processed at 20%.

When a medical withdrawal is approved, account adjustments to tuition and financial aid will be calculated based on the effective date on the withdrawal form.

- From the fifth through the eighth week, tuition refunds will be limited to 20%
- From the ninth through the twelfth week, tuition refunds will be limited to 10%
- There is no tuition refund beyond the twelfth week
- Any already graded accelerated courses will be billed at the full per credit rate.

Any reduction to Title IV funds will be determined using the Federal Financial Aid pro rata refund policy. University gift aid and all other non-Title IV financial aid will be reduced by the same percentage as the tuition reduction and returned to the source of the funds in question. Laboratory fees, University fees, housing costs and fees, refunds prior to withdrawal and any the fees already committed by the University on behalf of the student will not be refunded.
