What is Tuition Exchange?

- ▶ The Tuition Exchange (TE) is a reciprocal scholarship program for children and other family members of faculty and staff employed at over 600 participating institutions.
- ▶ Tuition Exchange, a 501-c3 non-profit association of colleges and universities, was founded over 60 years ago with the purpose to make careers in higher education more attractive.
- ▶ We do this through a reciprocal scholarship program, which finances college tuition for the children and other family members of faculty and staff employed at participating institutions.



How Do I Know If I Am Eligible to Participate?

- ▶ The employee must submit a Tuition Exchange application and the applicable dependent verification information to the Duquesne University Office of Human Resources. It will be determined if the employee or their dependent is eligible for the exchange (this process is called certification). Concurrently, the employee or their eligible dependent applies for admission to the participating university or college of interest.

Deadline:

- ▶ *The 2023/2024 Application will be available in early fall. You should apply no later than the earliest college admission deadline at the institution you are considering. For the 2023-2024 academic year Duquesne University's deadline is November 15, 2022.*
