

About The Graduate Outcomes Survey

The Class of 2020– 2021 Graduate Outcomes Survey consists of students who graduated in August 2020, December 2020 and May 2021. An online survey was conducted by the Duquesne University Center for Career Development prior to graduation and concluding about three months after graduation. Email reminders were also sent at regular intervals to those who did not respond to the initial survey. Additionally we secured data from Faculty and Department Chairs, as well as social media sources. **The result of these combined sources gave us a 75% Knowledge Rate of the graduating class.** A Knowledge Rate is defined by the National Association of Colleges and Employers as the percent of graduates for whom the institution has reasonable and verifiable information regarding a graduate's post-graduation status.

Relevance to Major


94% of the respondents indicated that this position was related to their major.

Career Related Experiences

75% of the respondents reported having one or more internship or career related work experiences. Of students reporting internship experiences, the average number reported per student is three.
