Summer Federal Work Study Terms and Conditions

Awarding Procedures:

- Students will be awarded Federal Work Study for the summer 2018 if they demonstrate eligibility based on the information provided on the FAFSA. In addition, students must meet one of the following conditions:
 - Students who are enrolled at least half-time in the summer will have their summer Federal Work Study count towards their financial aid for the 2017-2018 academic year (including fall/spring/summer).
 - Students who are **NOT** enrolled at least half-time in the summer will have a portion of their summer Federal Work Study eligibility count towards their future 2018-2019 academic year (fall/spring) financial aid as “expected savings”.
- Actual earnings and the corresponding expected savings are calculated at the close of the Summer 2018 term.

Eligibility:

Students will be notified by the Financial Aid Office of their eligibility. Eligibility for Summer Federal Work-Study **DOES NOT** guarantee placement in a position. No hours may be worked until eligibility and placement are finalized by the Office of Human Resources.

Placement:

Placement is coordinated by the Office of Human Resources **after** eligibility is established. The Financial Aid Office will notify the Office of Human Resources of all accepted awards. To finalize job assignments, eligible students must contact the Office of Human Resources. Students may work up to 28 hours/week during the period of May 14 to August 24. Students carrying 6 or more summer credits are eligible for Summer Federal Work-Study only if the Office of Human Resources determines that full-time summer placement is possible, or if there are departments requiring only part-time employees.
