Red Ring of Distinction/Achievement criteria for the nomination of a School of Pharmacy alumnus. This award is the highest level of recognition bestowed by the School.

- Professional Achievement
 - Demonstrated a long-term, sustained commitment and success in the field of pharmacy or pharmaceutical research.
 - Significant advancement in their career, including promotions, leadership roles, or noteworthy projects.
 - Contributions to the development of new methods, products, or practices within the pharmacy or pharmaceutical sciences fields.

- Contribution to the Field
 - Published influential research papers, articles, or books that have contributed to the advancement of pharmaceutical sciences.
 - Holds patents or has made significant discoveries in the field of pharmacy.
 - Presented posters, podium presentations, or on panels at conferences
 - Received awards, honors, or recognitions from reputable professional organizations in the field.

- Service and Leadership
 - Professional Organizations: Active involvement in professional organizations related to pharmacy, including leadership positions or board memberships.
 - Mentorship: Actively mentored student pharmacists, pharmacy interns, or young professionals.
 - Community Engagement: Involvement in community service or public health initiatives.

- Ethics and Professionalism:
 - Upholds the highest standards of ethics and professionalism.

- A formal nomination form that includes detailed information about the nominee's achievements and contributions outlining why the nominee deserves to be inducted into the Hall of Distinction/Achievement
